- 1. Alderman Michelle Smith and 18th District Commander Daniel O'Shea presented to the members. Issues related to ethics reform, AirBNB reform, and working with the 18th District police were discussed by Alderman Smith. Current neighborhood crime statistics and efforts to combat crime were presented by Commander O'Shea. Questions were asked of Commander O'Shea after his presentation.
